


# On our way to climate neutrality by 2030

## Our climate target

RTL Group supports the international goal of limiting global warming to 1.5°C compared to pre-industrial levels. We decided to become **carbon neutral by 2030**, including both company-related emissions (scope 1 and 2) and emissions from the production of its programmes and products (scope 3). The goal is to **reduce** the **RTL Group's total emissions by more than 50 per cent** compared to the 2018 baseline. As of 2030, RTL Group will offset all remaining emissions.

### Current non-financial reporting
